

## Egyptian National Identification Card General Guide

1- **Original Egyptian Birth Certificate** (computerised) If not available then valid Egyptian passport.

**2- Marital Status Documents:**

- Marriage Certificate
- Divorce Certificate.
- Widows: Marriage certificate and death certificate of the spouse are required.

**Please Note:** Any Australian Documents must be authenticated from DFAT then certified and translated from the Egyptian Consulate.

**3- Proof of Current Occupation:**

- Letter from employer authenticated from DFAT, translated and legalised from the Egyptian Consulate.

**STUDENTS:**

- Letter from School/University indicates enrolment. The letter must be authenticated from DFAT, translated and legalised from Egyptian Consulate.

**Business Owner:**

- Certificate of business ownership. Must be authenticated from DFAT, translated and legalised from the Egyptian Consulate.

**4- Proof of Address in Egypt**

- Ownership Contract
- Lease Contract
- Rent payment receipt
- Electricity, Gas or Telephone receipt

In case of non-availability of the above-mentioned documents proving address in Egypt, the address will be in the ID "RESIDENT ABROAD".

Processing time can take up to several months.

**Remark:**

**In case of non-availability of one of the above-mentioned documents, the committee will be unable to accept and issue National Identification Card for the applicant; therefore, all required papers should be available before the committee arrives Sydney.**
